Graduation Requirements

Graduates must have a minimum of 27 credits.

- Bible 4 credits (2 minimum if transfer student)
- English 4 credits (English I, II, III, & IV)
- Math 4 credits (Algebra I, II, III, Geometry, or Pre-Calculus)
- Social Studies 4 credits (American Government/Geography, World History, U.S. History and Economics)
- Science 4 credits (Biology, Introduction to Chemistry and Physics, Chemistry, and Physics)
- Health and Physical Education 1/2 credit each
- Computer Literacy 1/2 credit
- History and Appreciation of Fine Arts 1 credit
- Introductory Spanish 1/2 credit (beginning with class of 2009)
- Spanish I & II -1 credit each
- Community Service Project (75 hours minimum = 1 credit)
 - o Transfer students are responsible for 20 hours per year
- Accounting 1 credit
- Logic 1 credit (beginning with class of 2007)
- Elective 1 or more credits

PRE-COLLEGE CURRICULUM

Entering freshmen at public universities in the Commonwealth of Kentucky are required to have completed the pre-college curriculum. Some colleges and universities may require more than just the minimum.

- 4 English
- 3 Math (Algebra I, II, Geometry)
- 1 Health and Physical Education
