

# IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear HCA Parents,

In preparation for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year, please take a moment to review the new Kentucky State Law regarding School Health Requirements for the 2018-2019 school year. This new law will impact <u>EVERY STUDENT</u> attending schools in Kentucky.

- All students in grades K-12 <u>must</u> have two doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine. The Hepatitis A vaccine is a series of two shots that must be given six months apart. In order for the two shot series to be completed by August 2018, the first shot should be given in February. <u>MANY</u> health care providers and local health departments have been administering the Hepatitis A vaccines for the past several years, SO your student may already be compliant with the new regulations. Please CHECK WITH YOUR STUDENT'S IMMUNIZATION PROVIDER or the Local Health Department.
- 2. In Order to attend school, any student age 16 years old or older must ALSO show proof of having two doses of the Meningococcal vaccine. The first dose has been required for 6<sup>th</sup> grade entry, and <u>NOW</u> a booster is required at the age of 16.

### ALL STUDENTS MUST OBTAIN A NEW IMMUNIZATION RECORD THAT SHOWS HE/ SHE HAS RECEIVED ALL AGE APPROPRIATE VACCINES. THIS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR AUGUST 2018 SCHOOL ATTENDANCE.

### Physical Exams needed for the 2018-2019 school year:

The following students will need proof of a physical exam completed on a Kentucky Preventative Exam Form. Your child's primary care provider should have these forms in their office or you can stop by the front office to pick one up (A sports physical will not be accepted). **\*If your student will be in Pre-K3 or Pre-K4 August 2018:** 

(Pre-K students must have a yearly physical, & vision exam.)

### \*For any student that will be in kindergarten August 2018:

(Kindergarten students must have a physical and a dental exam)

### \*For any student that will be in sixth grade August 2018:

(Sixth grade must have a physical)



NTID- Non-traditional Instruction Days

### Dear Parents,

The 2017-2018 school calendar was recently altered to make up the days missed due to inclement weather thus far. The following days were altered/added: March 16 (1/2 day), May 21 (full day), 22 (full day), 23 (1/2 day).

In an effort to avoid extending the school year any further, the board approved the use of NTID packets better known as "snow day packets." NTID allows for the continuation of learning when school cannot be in session due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., inclement weather, flu, etc.).

These packets will focus on skill development, content enrichment, or remediation. The ultimate result is less loss of instructional time and an increased ability to learn new content when school is back in session. Additionally, this plan will reduce additional make-up days having to be added to the school calendar.

### **Delivery:**

Both digital and paper/pencil lessons will be available for students in all grade levels. Enclosed are the packets for elementary students grades K-5. Middle/High school students will be given packets upon request for the following reasons: unavailability of internet access at home, no access to a printer. Please let your teachers know if you need printed copies (MS/HS).

### Communication:

When a calling post message goes out upon the determination of no school, you'll be instructed as to what packet day is to be completed.



### Teacher Availability:

Teachers are required to maintain a minimum online presence (email, social media, Plus Portals, Remind, etc.) from 8-11 am and 12-3 pm. The forum choice is left up to each individual teacher.

#### **Student Accountability:**

Students will be required to complete <u>all</u> tasks assigned during a NTID and submit them the next day school is in session. Up to two days of extended time will be given to ensure students have enough time/guidance to complete their work successfully. These will be graded and the scores added to Plus Portals.
