Get a standard size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. Need shoeboxes? Preprinted boxes are available online.


4 Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note and photo.

Long before shoeboxes arrive in more than 100 countries, volunteer National Leadership Teams train pastors and community leaders who want to share the Gospel and bless children.




DISCIPLESHIP & MULTIPLICATION

OUTREACH EVENTS
