

Thank you, from the bottom of my heart, for entrusting the faculty and staff of HCA with your students! They bring a joy to this building and this campus that is beyond measure.







In the last couple of years, we've also expanded our efforts to remote Pacific islands where we've already communicated this life-changing message to tens of thousands of children. We're also working in unreached ethnic groups, some of whom have never heard the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ before. Praise Him, new churches are starting!
