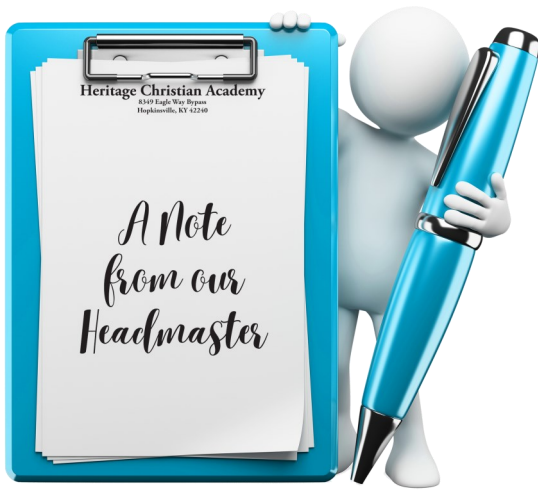

In Philippians 4:9, Paul writes these words of encouragement, “The things you have learned, received, heard, and seen in me, practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.” Through this encouragement, he reminds the Philippians of characteristic of God that remains essential in his day as much as it is in ours – that He is the God of peace. Access to the God of Peace remains, as Dave Ramsey frequently says, “...is to walk daily with the Prince of Peace, Christ Jesus.”

In addition, though, Paul speaks with great courage as he offers himself as an example for them to follow. Through his words of instruction, words of inspiration, and works of evangelism and devotion, Paul secures for them an anchor on which they can rely during troublesome times. I see a strong connection between the mission strategy of Paul and the mission statement of Heritage Christian Academy: “...to provide academic excellence based on Biblical principles” with a commitment to “...equip each student intellectually, socially, physically, and spiritually.” Please continue to lift up the faculty of HCA as they strive to be the example to the next generation of spiritual leaders.

The book fair for elementary students runs from November 1<sup>st</sup> to November 5<sup>th</sup>, and on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, elementary students may dress up as their favorite literary character. Remember that November 11<sup>th</sup> is Veteran’s Day and the school will be closed as well. 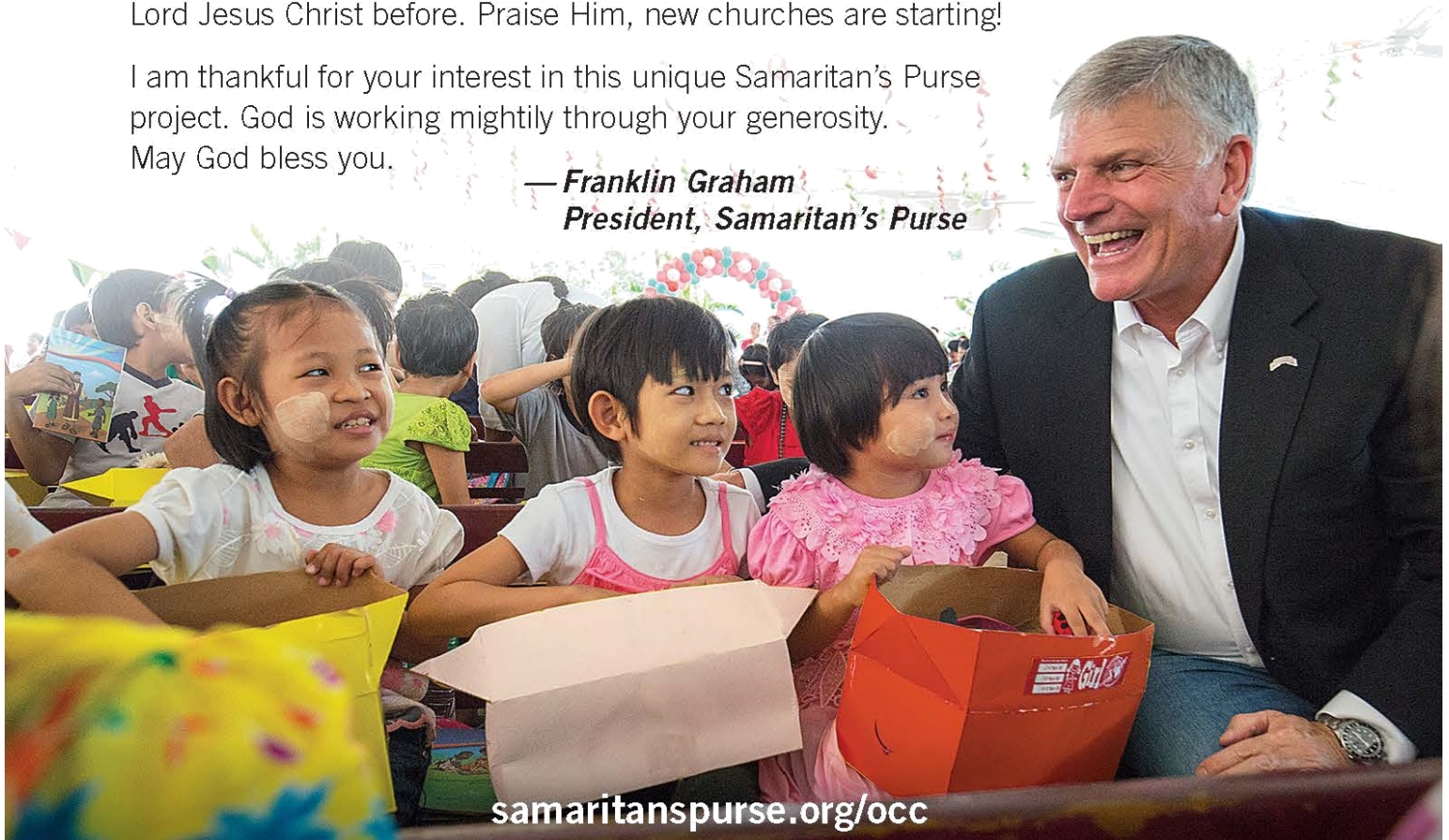

## 2 "WOW" ITEM

## 5 DONATE \$9 PER BOX

A donation of **\$9** per box is critical to cover shipping and other project costs. For easiest processing you can give online. If you use our **Follow Your Box** feature online, you can also discover the destination of your shoebox!
