As November begins, the Christmas music is already playing in my office. Christmas carols present the opportunity for reflective worship, as they clearly articulate the story of "the Word becoming flesh." Other people often remind me of the need to enjoy Thanksgiving before rushing into the Christmas season, and I agree. Thanksgiving has always been a time for family, food, and football, and, as the old hymn says, it is a time to "count your blessings, name them one by one."

However, if we are reflecting on reasons to be thankful, we must first pause at November 11^{th} – Veterans Day. During my childhood, I would hear stories told by my dad, who served in the Air Force, and my grandfather, who served in the Marine Corps, but at that time the nation had concluded the conflict in Vietnam, and had not begun Operation Desert Shield.

Moving to Kentucky and living so close to Fort Campbell, especially as the War on Terror began, has given me an infinitely greater appreciation for those who serve and have served in the Armed Forces. Seeing the imminent danger that they face daily, hearing all the ways that families cope with long deployments, and knowing that each of these individuals and their families volunteered for this responsibility is a truth that is often difficult for me to process. There is simply no way to adequately express how thankful I am for those who "stand on a wall and declare, 'no one is going to hurt you tonight...Not on my watch" (*A Few Good Men*). I hope that rather than rushing into the Holiday season, as I am apt to do, you and I will take time to remember and revere those who willingly serve us through the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, and now Space Force. They deserve our gratitude!


DEAR FRIEND,
