



With that in mind, I always enjoy hearing from students and families about the status of HCA. In these past few months we have been able to return a normal school schedule, have witnessed several of our athletic teams return with state championships, have seen our PTF revived, and have gathered for a time of worship in the parking lot on a crisp autumn night! So, I agree with the Psalmist — “Give thanks to the Lord for He is good!”

In the Warrior Weekly there is a link to a survey through which you can share with me your thoughts on the beginning of the school year. Your responses are completely anonymous, so if you want to reveal your identity, you can do so through one of the boxes in which you can type. Otherwise, all I see are scores and comments. I truly appreciate everyone who has responded so far – there are a lot of instances to celebrate and a couple of obstacles to overcome. I know one area of concern is the parking lot during drop off and pick up times.

Until we establish some changes that will be permanent, you can help by demonstrating grace and patience during those times. During the morning drop off time, we will treat the entrance to the west of the school (towards the YMCA) as a one-way entrance with 2 lanes. This means that if you are turning across the bypass to enter the school (from the east), you may use the lane to the LEFT of the concrete median. However, this will require grace and patience as you get closer to the main parking lot, especially if someone in the right lane needs to go to the front of the building or someone in the left lane needs to go the back of the building. Please drive slowly, keep adequate space between vehicles, and use your turn signals.

As I have said before, my door is always open – but I may not be in my office, because it is important to me to be in classrooms and the lunch room! – I want to hear from you.



## 1 SHOEBOX



Get a standard size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. Need shoeboxes? Great preprinted boxes are available on our website.

## 4 PRAY

Most importantly, **pray** for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note and photo to delight the heart of the child.



## 2 "WOW" ITEM

Select a quality "wow" toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal to bless a child.



## 5 DONATE \$9 PER BOX

A donation of **\$9** per box is critical to cover shipping and other project costs. For easiest processing you can give online. If you use our **Follow Your Box** feature online, you can also discover the destination of your shoebox!



## 3 OTHER GIFTS

Pack full with other fun toys, hygiene items, and school supplies.



## 6 DROP OFF
