How is it already the end of November? In his poem, *A Psalm of Life*, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow encourages his reader to embrace the present, as he concludes, “Time is fleeting.” Several times throughout the book of Psalms, David offers reminders to “give thanks to the Lord, for He is good...,” an activity that also occurs in the present. We give thanks for the ways that the Lord provides for us, walks with us, stands beside us, supports us, and resides within us.

On several occasions, David continues that thought on the goodness of God by saying, “His love endures forever.” This truth allows us to remain thankful even when the details of our context become difficult. A good God chooses to love with an everlasting love – which means His love always exists in the present tense. As our hearts experience that love, we also experience a desire not to allow another moment to pass without giving thanks to the One who loves us. As our hearts experience that love, we also express our concerns and needs, with thanksgiving, to a good God, knowing that the peace of God protects our hearts in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:6-7). Indeed, time is fleeting, but we experience the love of God, the peace of God, and the hope of God as we remember to give thanks to the One who did not “spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all.” From my family to yours, Happy Thanksgiving!

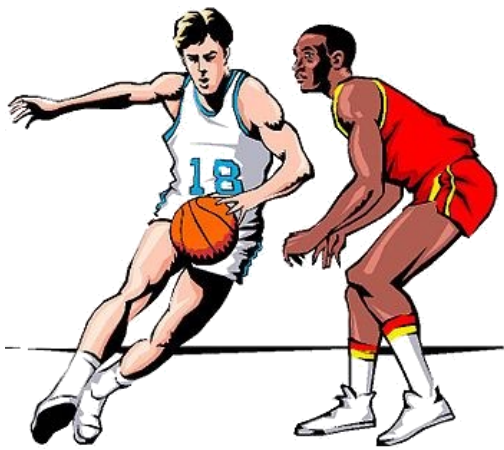
