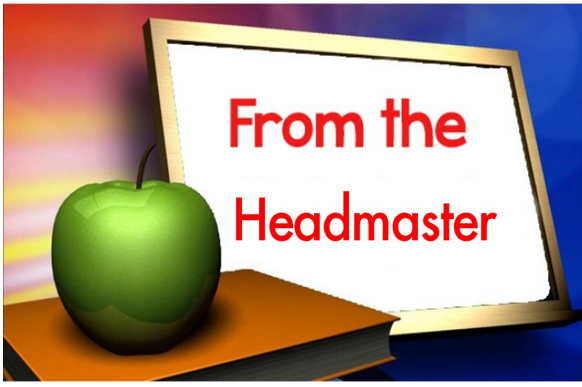

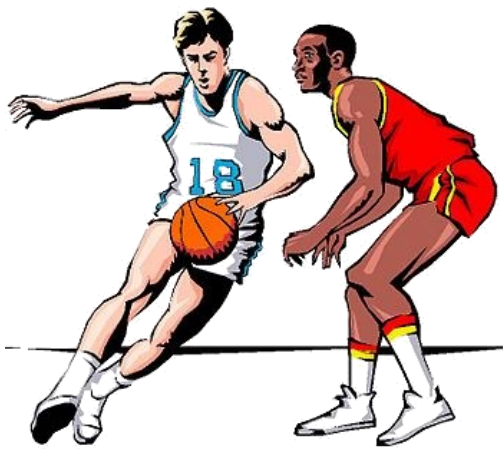
Lord's Supper together, we would often close the service by singing, "I'm so glad I'm a part of the family of God, washed in the fountain, cleansed by His blood..."
