"Tis the season of love" – or so they say. Ancient historians have debated the identity of the original St. Valentine, most choosing between two men, both beheaded by the Emperor Claudius II at different times in the third century. Throughout history, though several men have accepted the title St. Valentine, including one pope. According to an article on History.com, though, the association with romantic and platonic gestures of kindness did not appear until after Geoffrey Chaucer made in the connection in a fictional work entitled, "A Parliament of Foules."

In the modern era, traditions of Valentine's Day include sending flowers, stuffed bears, candies of all flavors, and

cards- many of which include a simple invitation: "Will you be mine?" or "Be my Valentine."
