At Heritage, parents and teachers partner together for the common goal of supporting the educational initiatives of HCA. The ParentTeacher Fellowship (PTF) meets on the first Tuesday of each month in lunchroom at 3:15, and is responsible for many of the major fundraising activities each year, such as the Harvest Festival and the Christmas Shop.

Currently, the PTF is spearheading a fundraising event that will culminate on Friday, March $18^{\text {th }}$. 2:00-3:00 $-6^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade Color Run (with the colored powder)
