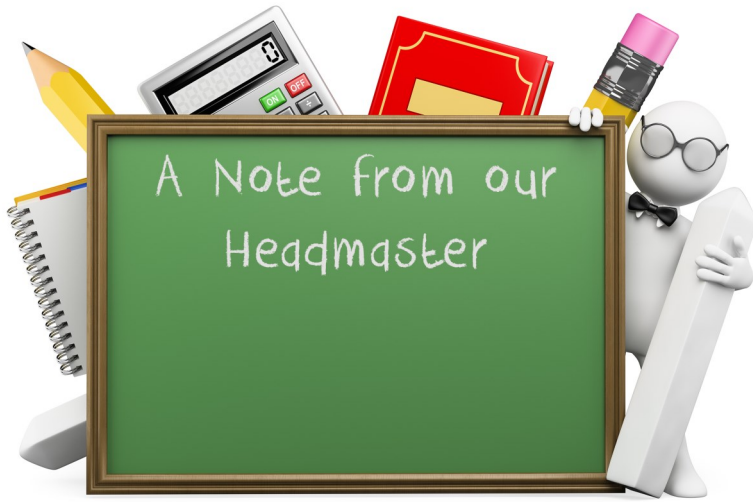

Hopefully by this time, you are aware that the Drama Department of HCA is performing the full-version of Disney's *Beauty and the Beast* at the historic Alhambra Theater in Hopkinsville this Friday and Saturday evenings at 7:00 PM. Out of curiosity, I searched for the history of the story and surprisingly I found that the first printed version appeared in 1740 in a collection of stories entitled, *The Young American or Tales of the Sea*. The author of the story claimed to hear the story being told on a ship

traveling to America*. That details of that story differs in many significant ways from the play that you will see this week. But, like other stories of this kind, over the course of time, changes occur, editors take creative license, and the final product only retains a few significant details of the original work.

This is not so with the gospel. Peter writes in the first chapter of his second letter

“¹⁶ For we did not follow cleverly devised stories when we told you about the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ in power, but we were *eyewitnesses* of his majesty. ¹⁷ He received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.” ¹⁸ We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.”

Jude echoes the unchanging nature of the gospel when he writes, “I felt compelled to write and urge you to contend for the faith that was *once for all* entrusted to God’s holy people.”

Early in the 1990’s, I was able to attend the Pastor’s Conference of the Southern Baptist Convention, and the theme that year emphasized a never-changing gospel in an ever-changing world. With regard to reaching the world with the gospel, I remember one pastor saying, “We may change our methods, but we will never change our message.”

In chapter 3 of that same letter, Peter reminds his readers

“⁸ But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. ⁹ The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.”

If the Lord tarries, we stand firm on a never-changing gospel, delivered to us by eyewitnesses of the Resurrected Lord! Praise His Name!

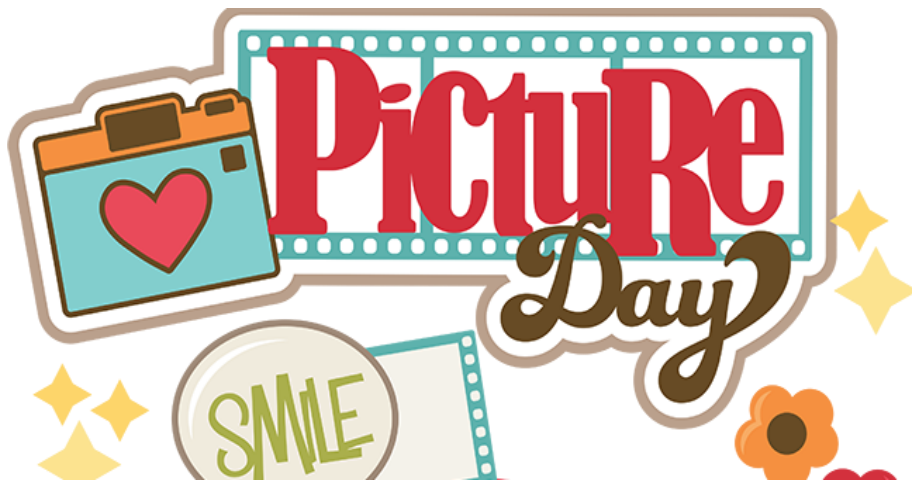
