

During his ministry, the Apostle Paul confronted several different divisive teachings in the churches which he mentored. The church at Corinth struggled with worldliness in a number of ways, but they also had some among their number who were teaching that there was no resurrection. Paul defends the reality of the resurrection with both logical and experiential arguments, and he declares, "If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied."

In that one sentence, Paul establishes the standard of our relationship with Christ. Through those words he communicates how Christ impacts our values, our relationships, our perspectives, our sacrifices, and our very existence. A person who is only nominally connected to Christ or who has "added" Christ to a current way of living maintains enough of the world to avoid the "pity" that Paul describes. That person can still find contentment and satisfaction in the ways of the world.

The person that Paul describes with that sentence is a person who has abandoned all to follow Christ; that person has "denied himself, taken up his cross, and followed..." Such is the level of commitment, devotion, service, sacrifice, and love, that without the hope of the resurrection in Christ, life loses its meaning. If we have put all of our eggs in that one basket (pardon the Easter metaphor), and that one basket is false, then "we are of all people most to be pitied."

Easter does not receive as much publicity as Christmas, and it maintains a much different role — the story of Easter, of the crucifixion and resurrection, calls us to believe and behave as those who have hope *in* this life and *for* the life that is to come. That call presents an "all-or-nothing" decision, for "there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which you must be saved." I hope that you had an opportunity this past Sunday, worship with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, being confident that the empty tomb provides proof that death has been defeated, salvation has been secured, and redemption has been realized. Jesus is alive! He is risen!




