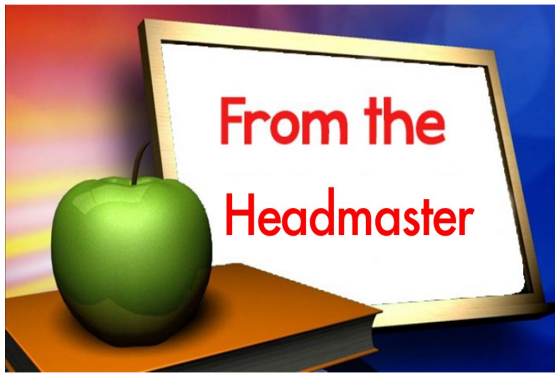

The end of a school year brings transitions. Transitions create new opportunities, confirm intentions from previous decisions, or sometimes, even cause us to change our plans. The song that is traditionally used in graduation ceremonies was written for an entirely different purpose. The title, “Pomp and Circumstance,” was taken from a line in Shakespeare’s *Othello*, and was written for the corona-

tion of King Edward VII. The song was first associated with graduation when the composer received an honorary doctorate degree from Yale in 1905, but it was played as the recessional, not as the processional. Over time, the march gained popularity at graduation ceremonies, eventually becoming the traditional music for the procession of graduates.

Graduation marks a significant transition in the life of a student, whether that student is completing Pre-school, Kindergarten, high school, college, or a earning a post-graduate degree. That transition signifies success, introduces opportunities, creates challenges, and demands decisions. As believer in Jesus Christ, we have assurances that our Heavenly Father walks with us each step of the way.
