This is the season of Advent – the season of preparation for the arrival of the Christ. At this time of year, many sermons focus on the themes of the season: love, hope, joy, and peace. There is also an example of someone who had the word of God, heard the word of God, and yet remained resolute in his defiance of God. King Herod, when approached by the wise men, knew who to ask about the location of the Messiah, and those he asked had no problem producing an answer. Rather being filled with joy at the fulfillment of His promise of a Savior, Herod was filled with jealousy. Without a doubt, the word of God will be seen and heard in abundance in the next few weeks. Faith will deliver love, joy, peace, and hope as we remain open to His voice and obedient to His word!


