

The Apostle Paul writes to the Galatians, "the heir is subject to guardians until the time set by the father... when the set time had fully come, God sent His Son... to redeem..." With these phrases, Paul references the celebrations that mark a child's transition into adulthood. Some cultures had specific ages for that promotion, much like the regulation that requires a person to be 16 years old in order to receive legal permission to drive or a person to be 18 years old to

vote. In a Jewish home that age was 12 and in a Greek home, that age was 18. In a Roman home, though, there was no specific age; the father determined the point at which a child matured into adulthood. He had the authority to set the time for that celebration.

The time of the birth of Christ was not chosen at random. The story of the Nativity, with the references to fulfilled prophesies, and Paul's commentary to a people tempted to return to a life that they had left, declare the Sovereignty of God; that God chose the perfect point in history to reveal His Son, the Savior. That phrase, "when the set time had fully come," also directs our attention to the words of Jesus in Acts 1:7 before His ascension, "It is not for you to know the times...the Father *has set* by His own authority..." The Christmas story points to the cross and the resurrection with declaration that Jesus would "save people from their sins." The Christmas story also points to His return at a time designated by the Father. The hope of all humanity *for* all eternity appears in the Christ child – sent "when the set time had fully come." And so, we join with the heavenly chorus, "Glory to God in the Highest!"


