

The book of Isaiah contains many wonderful promises from the Lord. He uses the prophet to foretell the birth of His Son and forecast the truth of the Gospel going into all the world as a light to the Gentiles. Through the prophet, He offers invitations to people, both far and near, that they might interact with Him and His Word. He invites people to listen, to reason, and to bargain so that they will be satisfied in Him. For these reasons, when God issues a warning, it is

essential that His words are received with respect. The first verse of chapter 29 contains a word of caution with regard to the control of the calendar: "Woe to you, Ariel, Ariel the city where David settled! Add *year to year*, and let your *cycle* of festivals go on" (NIV, italics mine). The warning in these words speaks of allowing time to pass without discerning the eternal significance of each day. At this time, the people of Israel had cluttered their lives with selfish ambitions, vain pursuits, and corrupted worship. Time was passing, days were full, yet the presence of God was missing in their lives. They worshiped without connection to their Heavenly Father.

Your situation may not be as dire as theirs. However, the words in Isaiah 29:1 disclose how easily keeping an eye on the calendar, planning the next event, anticipating the next opportunity, meeting the next milestone, or determining the next deadline may move our focus from the truth, "*This* is the day the Lord has made, I will rejoice and be glad in *it*" (NIV, italics mine). It is no secret that time is fleeting, school years end as quickly as they began and all of a sudden, your student is another year older. Moreover, there is a temptation to see what is next rather than what is now. The Psalmist writes, "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom" (Psalm 90:12, NIV). The encouragement I receive from this verse is this: don't engage cruise control or autopilot to the point that divine orchestrations and divine appointments pass by unnoticed. Enjoy the present for His presence wants to interrupt your process to proclaim His glory!


