

Newton's third law of motion states, in layman's terms, that for every action there is an equal and opposite reaction. While that may be absolutely true in the physical world, it is not so in the spiritual world. As John observes, "The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it" (1:5). Good and evil are not opposite equals in the spiritual world: "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them" - words of Elisha to his servant. "Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4). For the past few weeks, the Lord has laid upon my heart to add a time of prayer to our morning announcements. Last year, He led me to include a verse of the day, which has now turned into verses for the week which are read every morning. I know that good things are happening at HCA, and I believe that the Lord is moving in the lives of students, but I also believe the

enemy isn't resting either. This isn't a conflict of equal, opposing forces, but a confidence in the Lord to continue to move through the prayers of His people. Would you join me every morning, wherever you are, in prayer for HCA at 7:50? Isaiah 62 calls believers to take no rest for themselves and to give God no rest until He moves.

The annual Christmas concert (ES and MS music classes, school choirs) will be held at the Bruce Convention Center on December 5 at 6:00 this year. Mrs. O'hare, the teachers, and I are hoping that some of you can adjust your pick up and drop off routines so that the Bruce is included in those. Students will receive more information about that schedule as we get closer to the day. However, since we are using a different venue, we will need some help moving instruments, risers, and other pieces of equipment on the morning of December 5th. It would be wonderful if someone with a box truck or large enclosed trailer could be at the school on Monday afternoon, Dec 4th, so that we can load everything. Then on December 5th, around 7am, have an army of volunteers to help move those items to the Bruce Convention Center. After the program, we will like to have another army of volunteers load the items back into the truck or trailer to return to the school. Students can help us unload those on Wednesday, December 6th. 



Nominations Now Open!

ABOUT THE AWARDS

Seven national Military Child of the Year® (MCOY) Awards are presented to one outstanding youth from each service branch: Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, and the Space Force. The awards recognize the recipients for their resiliency, leadership, and achievement during their parents' service. Each recipient receives a \$10,000 cash award, a laptop computer, and are flown with an adult guardian and guest for a 3-night stay in Washington, D.C.

Recipients and their families will travel to Washington, D.C., April 9-12 for events, tours, and activities leading up to the Awards Gala. The gala will be held the evening of Thursday, April 11, 2024.

ELIGIBILITY

All applicants must meet each of the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a legal dependent of a service member or military retiree (Semifinalists must provide DEERS enrollment form)
- Be between the ages of 13-18 at time of nomination
- Be able to travel to Washington, D.C., to attend the MCOY Gala and other events April 9-12
- Provide letters of recommendation (if selected as a semifinalist)
- Be willing to participate in media and donor opportunities

WHEN TO NOMINATE

The nomination periods open September 6, 2023, and close December 3, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. Central.

HOW TO NOMINATE SOMEONE FOR A MILITARY CHILD OF THE YEAR® SERVICE BRANCH AWARD

Nominations can be submitted at militarychildoftheyear.org during the nomination period. Nominations can be made by anyone familiar with the child's achievements, and the form will include when and how long a parent has deployed, number of family moves, Gold Star Family or EFMP status, whether a parent is a wounded service member, nominee's volunteerism, and five short answers as to why the nominee is deserving.
