WEATHER RELATED SCHOOL CLOSINGS



In case of inclement weather or other local emergencies, listen to WNKJ (89.3 FM), WHOP (1230 AM or 98.7 FM) or Nashville stations for CBS, NBC & FOX17, if you do not receive a call from the Calling Post. Since we do not provide bus service, HCA will not necessarily follow public school weather related closings. It is our intent to hold classes even when there is inclement weather. Parents may use their discretion in determining if it is unsafe to drive. Students will not be penalized for tardiness or absences on these days.

Some of you may think the use of Non-traditional instructional days when inclement weather prevents in-person instruction. The benefit of non-traditional instructional days is the ability to schedule with certainty the last day of school so that families receive the longest summer break possible. Those days count toward the required number of school days necessary for a school year, whereas traditional snow days do not. Some years, the school calendar affords students the opportunity for traditional snow days, but we always try to be flexible when the weather impacts our school schedule.
